


WALL MOUNT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. MOUNTING THE LETTER BOX

- Place the letterbox in the desired mounting location, open the front and find the 4 mounting holes on the back wall of the outer box (marked A, B, C, D).
- For best results we suggest using a spirit level to mount the letterbox straight.
- Mark the 4 mounting holes with a permanent marker or pencil.
- Remove the letterbox and pre-drill the screw holes.

Note: Different substrates will require appropriate fasteners, ensure the correct fasteners are used with adequate weight rating.

- Once the holes are drilled put the letterbox up and screw through the holes into the wall. Tighten up all 4 screws.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

We are passionate about our products and have put together some information for you to get the most out of our letter box. Please read these instructions carefully and we hope you enjoy the Javi Letterbox.

Timber

Our Letterboxes are fitted with a CNC machined timber panel (Accoya - www.accoya.com) and is delivered in a raw finish giving you the freedom to finish it how ever you please. Timber products are affected by natural weathering when exposed to the environment. The weathering process will turn the wood a silver colour however the original colour can be retained by applying a rich penetrating timber oil or stain. Coating the timber will improve its longevity while enhancing its natural beauty.

Locks

Please note that our locks may require some maintenance over time, please take care when installing the letter box and ensure that no sand, cement or gravel enter the locks as it will impair the working parts. We suggest applying a small amount of lubricant (WD40 or equivalent) to the barrel every 6 months for improved functionality and longevity.

All of our letterboxes are fitted with locks, for users who wish not to use the lock simply open the letterbox and remove the CAM from the back using a spanner to unscrew. Keep the CAM in a safe place in case you wish to use it at a later date.

Keep your keys in a safe place, each set of keys is individual to each lock. Each Key has a number, ensure to note down your key number in case you ever need a replacement key. For replacement keys please contact us, we don't have replacement keys in stock but we can order them from our supplier which can take up to 4 weeks. This will incur an additional cost.
